- Physical violence inflicting bodily injuries of varying severity on women, endangering them, failing to help a person whose life is in danger, the life, health, and well-being of women through the commission of other offenses of a violent nature, physical violence, or threats to take other measures of such influence; a form of violence that infringes on liberty and other rights and freedoms protected by law;
- Violence threatening the lives of women by threatening them with physical, mental, sexual or economic influence or the use of measures of such influence; an illegal act (omission) that infringes on health, sexual integrity, honor, dignity and other rights and freedoms protected by law;
- Economic violence a form of violence against women in marriage, at work and elsewhere, in which women are provided with food, shelter and other necessary conditions for normal life and development. the right to action (inaction) leading to restriction of property rights, education and employment;
- Workplace violence a place that is directly or indirectly controlled by the employer, which must be present or present to perform work duties or perform official duties in accordance with the contract concluded with him;
- Psychological violence a form of violence that is expressed in insults, slander, threats, humiliation, and other acts aimed at restricting the will of women, including in the field of reproductive control, an act (omission) that causes the victim to worry about his or her own safety, inability to defend himself or herself, or to harm his or her mental health due to pressure or violence;
- Repression an act (omission) that does not provide for administrative or criminal liability, and degrades the honor and dignity of women.

Uzbek women are worried that they will not be able to tell their daughters directly as a result, many misunderstandings arise when girls talk to other women who have less experience and draw the wrong conclusions into their minds in their future lives.

But it is not good to blame one party for this, because no matter how eagerly you take the bride, you will not be able to serve her or teach her even trivial things. Spending too little time with your spouse can lead to many misunderstandings. If you become pregnant during this time, the environment will start to affect the baby. Preparing our daughters for marriage in the family and in educational institutions, so that such accidents do not occur, there are no divorces in the family, they need to be taught to be as calm, sweet, and open-minded as possible.

It is necessary to teach that the end of many things ends well in the absence of beautiful patience and arbitrariness, and the formation of a worldview is one of the important tasks before us.
