As a result, the number of disputes is increasing.

Divorce disputes are, in most cases, "unrestricted" disputes that, by their nature, participants, resolution and consequences, go beyond the marital relationship. Other family members also interfere in such marital disputes: mother-in-law, daughter-in-law, sister-in-law, etc. Separation disputes lead to the fact that the love between the couple weakens and disappears. This negatively affects the relationship between parents and children. What can cause conflicts between parents and children?
