This requires the teacher to be highly skilled in teaching. As a result of research conducted in the world on the quality of education and upbringing in preschool organizations, its assessment and quality management, a number of scientific results have been obtained, including the following scientific results: internal evaluation mechanisms for quality control of education and upbringing in preschool organizations have been developed ("life coaching" at the University of London, Institutes of Education (Great Britain); certification methods are described and quality assurance of the education quality management system (Bavarian Institute of Accreditation, Certification and Quality Assurance, Germany), etc.

The quality of education and upbringing in preschool educational institutions, its assessment, scientific and theoretical justification, the use of qualimetry, the use of integrated quality management are among the most important conditions for improving the system of continuing education. At the same time, qualimetric analysis becomes important.

Qualimetry is a field of scientific and practical activity related to the definition of diagnostic methods, the creation of theoretical foundations for the quantitative assessment of quality. Qualimetry is an integral part of qualitology (the science of quality). A number of studies are being conducted in the world to improve the quality management of education, including in the following priority areas: determining the establishment of uniform criteria and standards for ensuring the quality of education; developing the export of educational services; coordinating national accreditation systems for educational programs; improving quality management technologies. However, until now, the issues of professional development of employees of state and non-state preschool organizations and the improvement of a unified system for identifying the features of the management of the educational process in these educational institutions have not been fully implemented. In this regard, there is an increasing need to define pedagogical conditions for quality control, quality assessment systems in higher education, coordination of the activities of participants in the educational process and quality control of education.

CONCLUSION

Based on the above, today there is a need to study the problem of improving the quality of education and upbringing in state and non-state preschool educational organizations as a separate subject of research. To find a solution to the problem:

scientific characteristics of the concepts of "educational qualimetry" and "educational qualimetry" for advanced training of employees of state and non-state preschool organizations;
research of methodological and theoretical foundations of management of state and non-state preschool organizations from the standpoint of quality management;

- improvement of state requirements for state and non-state preschool organizations based on a differentiated approach;

application in practice;
