The Law on Education was adopted by the Legislative Chamber on May 19, 2020, approved by the Senate on August 7, 2020. Chapter 1. General Provisions Article 1. And after Shavkat Mirziyoyev came to the presidency of the Republic of Uzbekistan at the end of 2016, there has been an intensification of relations with other countries in various fields, including education. Uzbekistan's interest in cooperation in this area is related to the need to train personnel to work in schools and higher educational institutions. Another important aspect of educational cooperation is interaction with other countries aimed at better teaching in other languages.

According to Article 41 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan: "Everyone has the right to education" as a motto. The State guarantees free education to everyone. School education is under the control of the state." Education in Uzbekistan is compulsory for all. More importantly, it is accessible to everyone. As noted above, school education is provided free of charge by the State and is the duty of every citizen as one of the fundamental rights enshrined in the Constitution.

Reforms in the field of education, including schooling, are being implemented in stages in accordance with the "National Training Programme" of 1997. This program consists of 2 long stages of education, lasts 12 years and all 2 stages are mandatory<sup>2</sup>.

in the future forms an understanding and the correct attitude for further development [12] (Table 1).


