For example, the First President of the Republic of Uzbekistan I.A. Karimov noted in this regard: "In order to become a teacher, an educator must improve the mind and understanding of others, benefit from the light of enlightenment, and educate a true patriot, a courageous citizen. First of all, the educator himself must be able to respond to such noble qualities and possess them!"

From the above ideas, everyone understands what requirements are placed on today's teacher. What should a modern teacher be like? From the first days of independence, educators, psychologists and scientists have expressed their thoughts and opinions on this issue. At the same time, scientific research and studies on this issue continue. In the 21st century, the role of a teacher has developed further, and in the era of global changes, the development of science and technology, and the ever-growing communication media, it requires a teacher to have high skills, strong will, psychological strength, continuous search and reflection:

1. A teacher is, first of all, a person who feels the responsibility of upbringing, an experienced speaker, a promoter of culture and enlightenment.
2. A teacher must love his students, be able to connect his affection and feelings with the student, and be worthy of their love and affection.
3. The teacher must be able to explain to students the essence of societal changes, the essence of socio-economic changes, and reforms with a strong will.
4. A modern teacher is required to be aware of the achievements of science and technology, technology, communication news, and technical innovations.
5. A teacher should have comprehensive knowledge in his/her field, master the integration of all disciplines, and regularly conduct scientific work in his/her field.
6. A teacher should have a good understanding of the basics of pedagogy and psychology, and organize educational activities based on the age and psychology of students.
7. A teacher must use the latest and most modern forms of education and upbringing in his or her pedagogical activities.
8. The teacher is responsible for the education, initiative, and creativity of young people.
9. During the professional process, a teacher must know pedagogical skills, communicative competence, pedagogical techniques (speech, face, hands, feet, body movements, facial expressions, pantomime, manner, method) and their rules.
10. A teacher must have a culture of speech, whose speech should reflect the following features: being free from various styles, speaking only in literary language, the teacher's speech should be simple, fluent and understandable; be able to use wise words, phrases and proverbs, fables and literally told words at the right time, and should be free from jargon (words of certain professions or other specialists), barbarism (the unintentional use of the language of another nation, characteristic of the language of others), vulgarism (ugly words, swearing, insults) and conciliarism (using official language when it is not necessary).

The teacher should not forget that when communicating with students, colleagues, and parents, it is advisable to express his thoughts clearly and clearly. When communicating with them, he should not use words that cause embarrassment, but on the contrary, he should use words that recognize the successes of students (colleagues, parents) and increase their source of knowledge. During meetings and conversations, he should be kind, sincere, and friendly towards them. The appearance of a teacher who possesses such qualities increases his reputation among students, colleagues, and parents. In the current era, the demands on the teaching profession are increasing day by day, and it is up to the teacher to fulfill these demands. As an educator, a teacher must fulfill the following requirements: in addition to having a thorough knowledge of his profession, he must be aware of various sciences;

psychology, pedagogy, youth physiology, methods of educational work, school hygiene, and knowledge of his profession for young teachers;

- be aware of the latest developments in the world of technological education, computer and information technology;

- improve their skills in teaching and upbringing;

- have a creative approach to their profession;

- possess pedagogical techniques (logic, speech, use of teaching aids) and pedagogical tact;

- constantly increase their pedagogical knowledge and skills. In order to work successfully, every teacher needs to be skilled. The basic law of pedagogical labor is to achieve great results with little effort. A teacher should always be engaged in creative work. A capable and talented person who is engaged in pedagogical activity can improve his pedagogical skills. Pedagogical activity is inherently creative. The teacher forms the personality of the student, makes independent decisions when necessary, solves pedagogical problems, and skillfully manages the educational process. All this depends on the creative work, its essence, purpose and character. An experienced teacher should not be limited only to guiding students to success, but should strive to conduct research and improve his own skills. A modern teacher should be aware of technical developments. Society has high hopes for the future teacher. It follows from this that the teacher's correct belief in the future guides society to a bright future.
